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PROPOSED PROGRAM FOR TK-3

1. Focus Area: Music
2. Why?
 - a) Feedback indicate music as an area of high interest among EUSD families.
 - b) Music education in various forms are present at 4-8 schools but missing in our TK-3 schools.
3. How?
 - a) Sites will utilize certificated staff with music background to provide "push in" instruction.
 - b) Instruction will be provided during the school day for equity and access.
 - c) Estimated instructional time: 30 minutes/week
4. Curriculum: QuaverEd is proposed as the program.



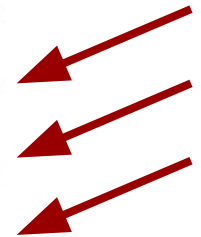
PROP 28 PROGRAMS

1. All students at all sites will have access to the arts and music opportunities.
2. **TK - 8: Certificated Staff Member**
3. Total FTEs:
 - TK-3: approximately 0.32 - 0.40 certificated per school
 - 4-6: 1 certificated staff member
 - 7-8: 1 certificated staff member
4. All school sites will offer Arts/Music opportunities.
